<u>Our Work</u>

The L&EC focuses on three areas: professional development, movement support, and mentoring.

Professional Development

We seek to deepen our understanding of the law and our connections with workers and organizers by regularly organizing continuing legal education panels. Past topics include:

- 1. The state of organizing and lawyering following *Hoffman Plastics*;
- 2. Reimagining labor law in light of the Occupy Movement;
- 3. Proactive litigation to support organizing workers;
- 4. Addressing legal and organizing hurdles facing the Fast Food Forward campaign; and
- 5. Struggles for democracy and collective bargaining rights in Detroit.

Movement Support Work

Our committee serves as a resource to workers. We have provided know-your-rights trainings to workers starting an organizing drive, research for a seminar for rank-and-file union members, and support for a coalition pushing for wage lien legislation. Moreover, our committee stands in solidarity with workers. To this end, we have written letters supporting strikers, picketed along-side locked-out workers, and marched with workers waging a campaign for workplace dignity.

Mentoring

As a community of progressive lawyers, students, and legal workers, we offer support and opportunities for others who seek to work for justice in the workplace and on the job. Each summer we host a reception for labor and employment interns and throughout the year we host social gatherings for our members in order to strengthen our community.
